

The first EUP AH&W call for Short-Term Missions (STMs) is now live! STMs are small travel grants aiming to foster scientific collaboration and advance animal health and welfare research across Europe, by providing a unique opportunity to **share scientific expertise, methodologies, equipment, and facilities** within the EUP AH&W network.

All **Early Career Researchers** (including PhD students) employed by member institutes of the EUP AH&W are eligible to apply.

STM Applications must address at least one of the following key EUP AH&W priority areas:

- Surveillance/Monitoring Systems, and Risk Assessment of animal health and welfare.
- Procedures, Methodologies, and Tools to assess animal health and welfare.
- Management and Husbandry Guidelines for farms (including aquaculture), during transport, and at slaughter.
- Vaccines and Treatments to improve animal health and welfare.
- Socio-economic Aspects of animal health and welfare.
